## FROM THE WORTHY PRESIDENT

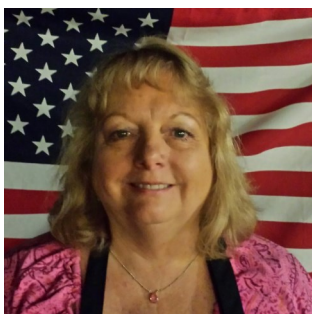
